

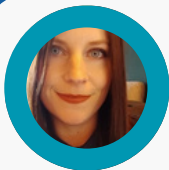

WORKSHOP: PROJECT-BASED LEARNING, GAMIFICATION & UNPLUGGED APPROACHES



Training course description:

This training course is designed to inspire teachers to try new methodologies and create lessons which are innovative and motivating for learners. We will spend some time on Project Based Learning, a method which aims to foster learning through collaboration and meaningful tasks; DOGME, which promotes teaching without resources and Gamification, a methodology which implements games and point systems as a way of motivating students. Teachers will have the opportunity to collaborate, create tasks and share ideas ready to take into the classroom. Opportunities will also be given for discussions, questions and sharing experiences. The training course aims to be as practical as possible, with a focus on language teaching, however many of the teaching methodologies could be adapted and taken into any subject.



Trainer Bio

Nicola McNab has been teaching English as a foreign and second language for over ten years. She has taught within a range of different contexts, such as London, Colombia, Argentina and Spain. Her teaching experience ranges from teaching and coordinating English courses for adolescent asylum seekers, to teaching Cambridge exam courses. More recently, Nicola has moved into teacher training and academic management, and has delivered teacher training sessions to teachers in Argentina, London and Spain. Nicola is hugely passionate about teaching and loves working with teachers in order to help create positive learning environments to engage both teachers and learners, and most importantly, facilitate the acquisition of language. Nicola has a Master's in Applied Linguistics and English Language Teaching from King's College London and is Cambridge DELTA qualified. She is currently in her final year of her PhD in Applied Linguistics and Language Teaching and has two published journal articles.
